Dixon Park, Playground and Recreation Board met on April 21, 2026. In the absence of Board Chair Vicky Tillman, Mayor Terry Webb presided over the meeting. Also in attendance were Board members Vanessa Schmitt, Eddie Branson, Brian Stull, and Ladon Mooney. Kellie Neal attended virtually. Gena Hisch was absent.

Minutes from the March meeting were not available; approval of those will be on the agenda in May.

As part of revitalizing the disc golf course, Ladon will seek sponsors for mulch and maybe landscaping timbers to redo the tees and targets areas. Eddie and Brian (and other volunteers if available) will replace the timbers and mulch. Vanessa continues to work on the new sign.

An estimate for insulating the splash pad building was received. Brian made a motion to approve \$300 for the project, seconded by Eddie, all ayes.

National Playground Safety Week Poster Contest: 2 entries were received, one in each age group. Both will be awarded first place. Posters will be displayed at Dixon Hardware, and Barb will be asked to post winners on the Facebook page. The Board reviewed options to encourage more participation if the contest is held next year.

Car Cruise In – June 13: The Board will seek sponsors for the event, and also reach out to people who may have vehicles to bring. Details for the event need to be finalized, such as concessions fundraiser and possibly yard games.

Summer Family Night – July 18: A screen and projector are still needed in order to show a movie. Possibly have a water slide. Will do corn hole and other yard games. Board will have concessions as a fundraiser.

Community Clean Up Day – Date TBD: Projects to address include fencing repairs, landscaping, playground painting/cleaning.

Vanessa will reach out to Barb for updates on ongoing grant projects. If the benches and picnic tables grant is awarded, the Board will seek sponsors to assist in the matching portion of the expense.
