

Dixon Parks, Playgrond and Recreation Board
May 12, 2026 Minutes

Dixon Parks, Playgrond and Recreation Board met in Session on May 12, 2026. In the absence pf Board Chair Vicky Tilman, Mayor Terry Webb presided over meeting. Also in attendance were Board members, Vanessa Schmitt, Eddie Branson, Gena Hisch, Ladon Mooney. Booard Members Kellie Neal and Brian Stull was absent.

Minutes from March (March minutes werent available at last meeting because of absence of a regular note taker) and April were approved on a motion from Eddie, second by Gena and all ayes. Budget was approved on a motion from Vanessa, second by Ladon and all ayes.

Events and subjects discussed:

Disc Golf – Vanessa updated us on progress, saying the sign Linda is providing for \$100 estimate, would be ready in 7-14 days. Eddie spoke of the numbers and flags being out of order, and will try to fix before next meeting.

Benches and Picnic Table grant (applied for not accepted yet) - Small Trash cans, for the benches through the park was discussed and decided to put on hold till bench grant is received. Eddie talked about us getting prices for the metal engraved or stamped “in memory of“ or sponsors plaques, (for the backs of benches) from trophy companies. Gena and Terry spoke of places to go (Gena suggested ABBA, Henderson) and bad expperiences with some. Vanessa suggested to ask Lida Nims for suggestions.

Community Clean up Day – still ned date : waiting for cooler weather september. Ladon was thank donating for her talking to Providence Cornerstone Hardware for mulch and her company has offered to pick up and deliver to park on clean up day. Discussed landscape timber verses landscape pavers, need to check prices.

We spoke of the broken window in storage building at park, Vanessa and Terry offered a windows they had to replace. Eddie said he would measure today for size. (I saw him doing it). Vanessa's window is single pane and will fit a 35.5 x 24 inches hole.

Downtown Planters – Vanessa, Kelly and Brian had offered to Hopefully plant next week, received a \$100 donation From the Atty Wilson of Dixon.

Splash Park – Mayor Terry uupdated us saying the additional features were in process of being shipped. They had plans to start working on getting it ready to turn on maintenance this coming week. Eddie udated us saying the insulation for the building holding the mechanics or splash feature has been put off to after Memorial Day to helop with heating and cooling of mechanics. He also said the plan he would get a 10% discount if he bought it so he would and get the refund later. Vanessa noted that the electric bill had gone down from \$600 -\$700 to \$250 this past month.

Car Cruise In – Vanessa would get with Barb tommorrow and get details on brochure and Barb would get advertisement in papers each week till June 13.

We discussed leaving a car space in between each car and start parking closet to soccer field in upper blacktop parking lot. Discussed using Cones.


