Dixon City Commission met in session Monday, April 11, 2022, 6 p.m. Attending were Commissioners Terry Webb (presiding due to Mayor's absence), Randy Norman, Dorris Crowley, and Jeff Graham, and City Clerk Barbara Goff.

Minutes were approved on a motion by Commissioner Crowley, seconded by Commissioner Graham, all ayes.

Bills were approved on a motion by Commissioner Norman, seconded by Commissioner Crowley, all ayes.

The City has submitted an application for a grant to install crumb rubber in the playground areas at Baker Park.

It was requested for the Code Enforcement Officer to be present at the next Commission meeting to provide an update.


The Mayor and Commissioner Norman plan to work together soon to create an advertisement for sidewalk repairs within the City.


A second reading of an ordinance related to leak adjustments was approved on a motion by Commissioner Norman, seconded by Commissioner Crowley, all ayes. One of the conditions for a leak adjustment is that the customer's bill they are requesting an adjustment for must be at least \$40 above their average billing. Previously the rate was \$30.

A second reading of an ordinance increasing the compensation rate for elected officials was approved on a motion by Commissioner Crowley, seconded by Commissioner Graham, all ayes. Effective January 2023, the mayor will be paid \$250 monthly and commissioners \$150 monthly.

A motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Norman, all ayes.
