

Dixon City Commission
Regular Session
Monday, February 14, 2022, 6pm

Dixon City Commission met in session Monday, February 14, 2021, 6 p.m. Attending were Mayor Carolyn Townsend (via Zoom), Commissioners Terry Webb, Randy Norman, Dorris Crowley, and Jeff Graham, City Attorney Ben Leonard, and City Clerk Barbara Goff. Also in attendance were Mark Moser from E&M, and Matt Wright.

Minutes were approved on a motion by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Graham, all ayes.

Bills were approved on a motion by Commissioner Crowley, seconded by Commissioner Norman, all ayes.

There have been no noteworthy changes within the departments over the last month, and nothing new was reported aside from water loss is at 2%.

The Commission had been presented a letter from Dixon Nuisance Board Chairman Teresa Johnson, with the Board's recommendation for Mary Mayes to be hired as the City's Code Enforcement Officer. Commissioner Crowley made a motion to hire Mrs. Mayes, seconded by Commissioner Webb, all ayes.

A bid from E&M for the proposed sewer project was briefly reviewed, at a total cost of \$28,973.00. The bid came in higher than expected due to the rising costs of materials over the last few months. Commissioner Norman made a motion to accept the bid from E&M for the proposed sewer project, seconded by Mayor Townsend, with the remaining members of the Commission voting nay. Since Mayor Townsend was participating via Zoom, to be clear of all votes, she called for an individual verbal vote, with the following results: Commissioner Graham – nay, Commissioner Webb – nay, Commissioner Crowley – nay, Commissioner Norman – aye. With three nays, the motion was denied.

It was decided the City would advertise again for new bids. The new advertisement will include that bids must have cost broken down by location.

Mayor Townsend has recently learned that APRA funds may be used for a variety of projects planned by the City, including sidewalk repair and remodeling the house the City owns near Baker Park. Commissioner Graham made a motion to place highest priority on sidewalks, seconded by Commissioner Webb, all ayes.


