

Dixon City Commission
Regular Session
Monday, October 14, 2024, 6pm

Dixon City Commission met in session Monday, October 14, 2024, 6 p.m. Attending were Mayor Dorris Crowley, Commissioners Terry Webb, Randy Norman, Jeff Graham and Peggy Poole, City Attorney Lindsay Durbin, and City Clerk Barb Goff. Also in attendance was Amy Matheny, a representative from the Green River Area Development District.

Following the pledge and invocation, Mayor Crowley invited Ms. Matheny to address the Commission. Ms. Matheny gave a brief overview and updates on grant projects, and answered questions from the Commission.

Minutes were approved on a motion by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Graham, all ayes.

Bills were approved on a motion by Commissioner Poole, seconded by Commissioner Norman, all ayes.

Water loss was at 12.5% for September. There are presently two known leaks within the City. Dixon Fire Department completed 15 runs during September.

A stop sign is down on Robert Hill Drive and will need to be replaced.

The Commission was presented a letter of resignation from the Park Board from Sondra Norman. The Park Board resignation was accepted on a motion by Commissioner Poole, seconded by Commissioner Webb, all ayes.

Mayor Crowley addressed the Commission regarding future meeting dates and times. The November meeting will fall on a holiday this year. Commissioner Norman made a motion to reschedule the November meeting to 10am on November 13, seconded by Commissioner Webb, all ayes.

Mayor Crowley asked the Commission to be in consideration of amending the ordinance that sets the monthly meeting in order to host meetings during a daytime hour instead of evening.

A motion to repeal the ordinance regulating business licenses within the City was made by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Poole, all ayes. A first reading is expected at the next meeting.

Commissioner Webb made a motion to enter closed session, referring to KRS 61.810c, seconded by Commissioner Norman, all ayes. Following, Commissioner Norman made a motion to resume the public meeting, seconded by Commissioner Graham, all ayes. There was no report.

Mayor Crowley asked the Commission to be prepared to set a date for the Christmas dinner at the next meeting.

A motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Poole, all ayes.
