Dixon City Commission met in session Monday, December 8, 2025, 6 p.m. Attending were Mayor Terry Webb, Commissioners Randy Norman, Peggy Poole, Robert Brown, and Mandee O'Leary, City Attorney Lindsay Durbin, City Clerk Barb Goff, Code Enforcement Officer Chris O'Leary, and Code Enforcement Board member Sondra Norman.

Minutes were approved on a motion by Commissioner Norman, seconded by Commissioner Brown, all ayes.

Bills were approved on a motion by Commissioner Poole, seconded by Commissioner O'Leary, all ayes.

Dixon Fire Department completed 25 runs in November.

Water loss for November was at 19%. Public Works is still searching for a leak on Stegal St.

Work has been completed grinding trip hazards on sidewalks along 132W. A Liability Grant from KLC provided some funding for the project.

The Park, Playground, and Recreation Board hosted the annual Veterans Day Celebration on November 15, which included a parade and some fundraising activities.

Mr. O'Leary reported that since the last meeting, one citation has been mailed, one new Notice of Violation has been mailed, and one case has been closed.

A second reading of an ordinance to adopt a supplement to the Code of Ordinances was approved on a motion by Commissioner Poole, seconded by Commissioner Norman, all ayes.

Mayor Webb announced that Mrs. Durbin has made the decision to step down from the position of the City's Attorney. Mr. Webb, along with the Commissioners, thanked her for her service over the past two years. Mayor Webb has started reaching out to potential candidates to fill the position and will present to the Commission soon.

Commissioner O'Leary approved the opening of a special bank account for the administration of the recently awarded Land and Water Conservation Fund grant, seconded by Commissioner Brown, all ayes. The account will be opened once GRANT funds are received, with the Mayor, Mayor Pro Tem, and City Clerk as authorized signors.

Mayor Webb reminded everyone that the City's Christmas dinner is this Thursday evening, and that Saturday is the Christmas parade and Cookies with Santa following.

A motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Poole, seconded by Commissioner O'Leary, all ayes.
