Dixon City Commission met in session Monday, April 13, 2026, 6 p.m. Attending were Mayor Terry Webb, Commissioners Randy Norman, Peggy Poole, Robert Brown and Mande O'Leary, City Attorney Bobby Murray, City Clerk Barb Goff, Code Enforcement Board members Sondra Norman and Stace Poole, and Kimberly Turner.

Minutes were approved on a motion by Commissioner O'Leary, seconded by Commissioner Poole, all ayes.

Bills were approved on a motion by Commissioner Brown, seconded by Commissioner Norman, all ayes.

Dixon Fire Department completed 15 runs in March.


Water loss in March was at 37%. KRWA will return next week to help search for any leaks, but all currently known leaks have been repaired.

Commissioner Norman made a motion to accept resignation submitted by Code Enforcement Officer Chris O'Leary, seconded by Commissioner Poole, all ayes. The Code Enforcement Board has interviewed Kimberly Turner, and recommended her to be hired as Code Enforcement Officer at a monthly salary of \$200. Commissioner Norman made a motion to approve the recommendation, seconded by Commissioner Brown, all ayes.

Commissioner Brown made a motion to authorize Code Enforcement Board Chair Norman, Code Enforcement Officer Turner, and Attorney Murray to attend a one-day Code Enforcement seminar in Calvert City, hosted by the Kentucky League of Cities, seconded by Commissioner Poole, all ayes. The registration expense is \$100 per attendee.

Commissioner O'Leary made a motion to authorize Mr. Murray to contact the owner of the property located at 118 N Stegal St, seconded by Commissioner Norman, all ayes, in effort to resolve the City's lien against the property.

A motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Poole, seconded by Commissioner Norman, all ayes.
