

Dixon City Commission
Regular Session
Monday, March 10, 2026, 6pm

Dixon City Commission met in session Monday, March 10, 2026, 6 p.m. Attending were Mayor Terry Webb, Commissioners Randy Norman, Peggy Poole, Mandee O'Leary and Robert Brown, City Attorney Bobby Murray, City Clerk Barb Goff, and Code Enforcement Board member Sondra Norman.

Minutes were approved on a motion by Commissioner Brown, seconded by Commissioner Norman, all ayes.

Bills were approved on a motion by Commissioner Poole, seconded by Commissioner O'Leary, all ayes.

Dixon Fire Department completed 26 runs in February.

Water loss for February was 53%. A representative from Kentucky Rural Water Association has brought a certain listening device to the City and was able to locate several leaks, two of which were major. The two major leaks have been repaired, and Public Works continues to search for other leaks and make repairs. Daily water usage has dropped by more than 60,000 gallons since the visit from KRWA.

Webster County Road Department has made street repairs needed near the WC Health Department.

The Park, Playground and Recreation Board will be hosting an Easter Egg Hunt on March 28 at Baker Park. They are also accepting entries for a Playground Safety poster contest in honor of National Playground Safety Week in April.

The City is beginning to see some progress regarding the Land and Water Conservation Fund grant awarded last year. Fencing around the basketball court has been installed.

Mrs. Norman reported that Code Enforcement Officer Chris O'Leary has mailed 3 Notice of Violations and 3 citation reminders with late fees since the last meeting.


Commissioner Norman made a motion to approve a second reading of an amendment to Ordinance 31.37, seconded by Commissioner Brown, all ayes. The amendment will allow the Commission to annually review the salary of the City Attorney instead of having a set salary.

Mayor Webb noted he has completed a review of the City's insurance policies with the Kentucky League of Cities.

Commissioner O'Leary made a motion to approve a resolution for the City to apply for a Crumb Rubber/Tire Derived Products grant, seconded by Commissioner Poole, all ayes. The City will submit an application to purchase picnic tables and benches to be placed at Baker Park. Monetary and in-kind labor matching will be shared by the City and the City's Park, Playground and Recreation Board.

A resolution to authorize the mayor to sign documents with FEMA regarding the flood repairs on the walking trail at Baker Park was approved on a motion by Commissioner Norman, seconded by Commissioner Poole, all ayes.

A motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Poole, seconded by Commissioner O'Leary, all ayes.


The purpose of the meeting was for a closed session under KRS 61.810(1)(c), proposed or pending litigation, and for a decision regarding the closed session discussion.
